HOLMES QUOTED IN ATTACK UPON BORAH'S SCHEME

Doubt Changing Constitution Would Protect State Laws

WASHINGTON, March 5.—From the grave voice of Justice Oliver Wendell Holmes, challenges proposals such as Senator Borah's to protect state laws from the Supreme Court.

After more than 10 years on the Supreme Court, Justice Holmes in 1917 led the Harvard Law School.

"I do not think the Union would be improved if it could not make that declaration as to the laws of the several states."

"The one in my place sees how when a local policy prevails with those who are not trained to national views, and how often action is taken that embodies what the common sense was unable to see."

Doubt Expressed
But in some quarters doubt is expressed that Borah's proposed rewriting of the Fourteenth Amendment and its limitation of the "privileges" would stop the court from holding state laws invalid.

From some of the recent opinions of the court it is clear that the Fourteenth Amendment has been based on the "privileges" clause of the Fourteenth Amendment.

It is the provision that all American-born and naturalized persons are citizens of the United States and of the state wherein they reside.

State Infringement
Borah's proposed to limit the state's ability to abridge the privileges and immunities of citizens of the United States.
